NO SMOKING EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED SMOKING AREAS

Non-exhaustive list of prohibited items

PROHIBITED ITEMS



Bags larger than A4



No Smoking



Umbrellas and helmets



Laser pointers



Bottles*, jugs, cans, glass, etc.



Pyrotechnics



Alcoholic drinks and drugs**



Racist, xenophobic, political and religious propaganda materials



Flagpoles more than 1m in length and 1cm in diameter



Flags larger than 2.0m x 1.5m (6.5' x 5.0')



Professional cameras or video cameras



Weapons, explosives, knives, or anything that could be adapted for use as a weapon



Promotional or commercial objects or materials



Aerosol sprays



Face covering



Drones



Mechanical or electronic sound-emitting devices, such as megaphones

* except on duly evidenced medical grounds

- No bags larger than A4
- No weapons of any kind
- No bottles, jugs, cans, glass
- No fireworks, flares or other pyrotechnics
- No spray cans, flammable, corrosive substances, dyes
No laser pointers
- No drones
- No drugs or alcohol
- No insulting, racist, xenophobic, sexist, religious, political or other prohibited material
- No promotional materials including banners, signs, leaflets
- No flexible flagpoles exceeding 1m in length and 1cm in diameter
- No banners or flags exceeding 2 x 1.5m
- No sound-emitting devices such as megaphones
- No professional camera or sound recording equipment
- Anything else deemed dangerous by the local authorities.

Posters of Prohibited Items will be placed at all public screening areas;
